## Donation Options through Automated Collections

When you come to donate we will ask to see identification, give you a donor questionnaire to fill out, and give you an Important Information sheet to help clarify your possible questions. Then we will recommend a donation procedure that is best suited to your blood type and current patient need.

There are a variety of ways for donors to donate through the Automated Collection Program. This program allows you to donate blood components. Based on your blood type you may be asked to donate different components each time you give.

LifeShare Blood Centers has the latest in automated technology to collect red cells, platelets and plasma. Your automated component donation helps patients with serious medical conditions including: leukemia, cancer, severe burns, trauma, aplastic or sickle cell anemia, heart disease and transplants.
